Performance Season is Here!



Our studio's 23rd annual spring performances will be held Saturday, June 16 through Monday, June 18. Each class will perform one choreographed dance number at Shorecrest Performing Arts Center. **A preliminary schedule of show and dress rehearsal times will be posted online the first week of February.**

The performance cost is included in spring tuition and pays for: costume, accessories, HD digital recording, theater time, flowers, and a performance program. Photographs are taken at dress rehearsal by Yuen Lui and may be purchased separately.

Please note our **dress rehearsal is mandatory**. Dancers must arrive dressed and stage-ready 20 minutes before their scheduled rehearsal time. Plan on being at the theater for about an hour, but note that the actual time needed will depend on the promptness and readiness of performers. **Dancers who do not attend dress rehearsal will not be able to perform.**

Performances and mandatory dress rehearsals are held at Shorecrest Performing Arts Center - 15343 25th Avenue NE, Shoreline, WA 98155.
