WAYNE WURZER SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Wayne Wurzer - co-owner of All That Dance and late husband of Maygan -- held an appreciation for dancers who were committed to their craft. He valued being a contributing member of the team and he was continually impressed with the hard work demonstrated by Company dancers. Wayne died in December of 2012 after a two-year battle with cancer. In honor of him, a scholarship fund has been established.

All Company dancers are encouraged to apply for a scholarship to cover the cost of the Company fee (excluding costumes). Two are awarded each year: one for the full cost and one for fifty percent of the cost. Recipients of the scholarship will be notified via e-mail along with their casting. This is a merit-based scholarship and dancers will be judged on their application, essay ("The Importance of Dance in My Life"), and teacher endorsements.

If you would like to be considered, please submit your application to Moire Hale, Company Director, before or at the audition on **Sunday, January 6**. Late/incomplete submissions will not be accepted.

Please take advantage of this opportunity. Wayne always went out of his way to help others and this is one way his legacy will live on.
